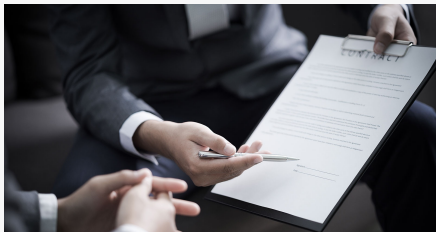


Government Sponsored Schemes
